This Equipment List is for 3 days and includes the clothing your camper wears on the day she arrives at camp. No one knows your camper's habits like you do, so pack accordingly. We suggest packing all items in a duffel bag. Suitcases tend to be bulky so duffel bags are preferred. The soft sided duffels with zippers running the length of the bag are easiest to live out of for a week. Camp is at 5,500 feet so nights can be in the 30's while days are in the 80's.
