Girls enjoy spectacular days of fun in the mountains, with friends, new adventures! Campers are supervised by trained adult Camp Staff at all times. Parents provide transportation to and from camp. Fee covers meals, program supplies and all activities.

All campers participate in flag ceremonies, horseback riding, mountain biking, nature, crafts, swimming, slingshots, s'mores, campfires, skits and singing. In addition to these programs, 4th thru 6th grade campers do archery and 7th thru 12th grades do archery and canoeing.

4 Day 3 Night Events

Campers attending 4-day events are supervised by paid camp staff. Parents bring their campers to camp and pick them up 4 days later. Camp staff are college-aged individuals who have been fingerprinted, background checked, taken state required online training in Mandatory Reporting, Harassment Training and attended an onsite 5-day training at El-O-Win. Longer sessions provide opportunities to explore a wider variety of activities and potentially repeat favorite activities.
